
\mathbf{I} n its fourteenth year, International Women's Ministries saw recordbreaking donations totaling over \$60,000. Due to the generosity of our donors, missionary partners were supported monthly as they did the work of spreading the gospel; dozens of homes and buildings were restored after the devastation of Typhoon Odette in the Philippines; educational support, training, and transportation was provided to teachers in Nicaragua; a missionary was able to return to her beloved Zambia; and young women and girls received feminine hygiene products and education in Ghana.
